Ranjit Kumar [Das](#) the speaker of Assam Legislative assembly made a visit to historic Borengajuli [Sankar Dev](#) Satra (Vaishnavite Monastery) located near Indo-Bhutan border area of [Udalguri](#) district on Sunday.
