

RDX seized from bus in Jagun



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TINSUKIA: The [Tinsukia](#) police have averted a huge explosion in the [state](#) as they seized some explosive materials from a passenger bus in Jagun on Wednesday.

Acting on a tip off, a police team in Jagun conducted a checking on the bus which was coming from [Arunachal](#) Pradesh where a huge cache of RDX was [found](#) inside a bag.

The police then questioned the [driver](#), assistants of the bus along with the passengers. But later the passengers were allowed to go and detained the [driver](#) and his assistants for further interrogation.

"Investigation is going on. Right now we are not in a position to divulge the findings in detail," said a senior police officer in Jagun.

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
