A two-day [training](#) on Search and Rescue for volunteers was organized on February 17 and 18 by the District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA), Golaghat in association with the Assam State Disaster Management Authority ([ASDMA](#)) and [National](#) Disaster Response Force at District Library auditorium.
