

Rhino census from March 15



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Assam forest department is all set to launch the state-wide rhino census from 15 March.

The census will be conducted in Kaziranga and Orang National Park and Pobitora Wildlife Sanctuary. The entire operation is expected to be completed by March 27. On 15 March census will begin in Orang. This would be followed by Pobitara on March 20. The census will cover Kaziranga National Park on March 26 and 27.
