

Rhino poaching riddles Orang



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Despite unprecedented measures rhino poaching refuses to die down in Assam putting in BJP-led government in a fix. Poachers in [Orang](#) sanctuary have killed a rhino to take away the horn in a couple of days back.

The incident took place near the Picholamukh forest camp where the poachers were believed to have struck and the carcass was spotted on Friday morning.
