

Rise of criminal activities in Dhubri

After the sudden transfer of the Superintendent of Police (S.P.) of Dhubri before election Deepak Choudhary, all types of criminal activities are on the rise after Pradip Kr Saloi, the ex-city S.P. took charge, people felt.

Ex-SP Choudhary had able to curb all types of illegal gambling counters of the town during his short tenure of fourteen months. But now more than 60 counters of Ending (last number game) are reopened across all the major locations of the town right under the nose of the police. Illicit country liquor business is also in rise.
