

RMC demanded ministerial from religious minority



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Kokrajhar, April 30: The Religious Minority Council(RMC) of Bodoland Territorial Council(BTC) region expresses their unhappy [over](#) recent cabinet expansion in the BJP led alliance government at the Dispur in which minority representation has been deprived from minister induction in the expanded cabinet. The RMC demanded minority representation in the [state ministry](#).

The Aminur Rahman faction of the RMC and Youth Wing of the RMC have alleged that the BJP led [state](#) government has been declined to the [welfare](#) of the minority peoples in the [state](#), so minority representation was saw deprived in the recent expanded cabinet [ministry](#).
