

Rs 8 lakh ex gratia for border victims



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The [Assam](#) government has announced an ex-[gratia](#) of Rs 8 lakh each to the families of persons [killed](#) in the [Assam](#)-Nagaland [border](#) violence.

Those [injured](#) in the [miscreant attack](#) would get Rs [50](#),000 each. Apart from it, the government will also give a grant of Rs [50](#),000 to every family, whose houses were burnt. A survey is underway on the number of houses.

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
