

Sahabuddin quits ABMSU

Sahabuddin Ali Ahmed, president of All BTC Minority Students Union (ABMSU) resigned from the presidential post and decided to join in ruling [Congress](#) party while existing general secretary Lafikul Islam Ahmed unanimously selected president of the union.

Ahmed told that he has quit the students union following personal reason to involve himself into active politics. He has resigned from the president of the students union on February 18 and the general body meeting of the students union formally accepted his resignation that has been convened on Sunday.
