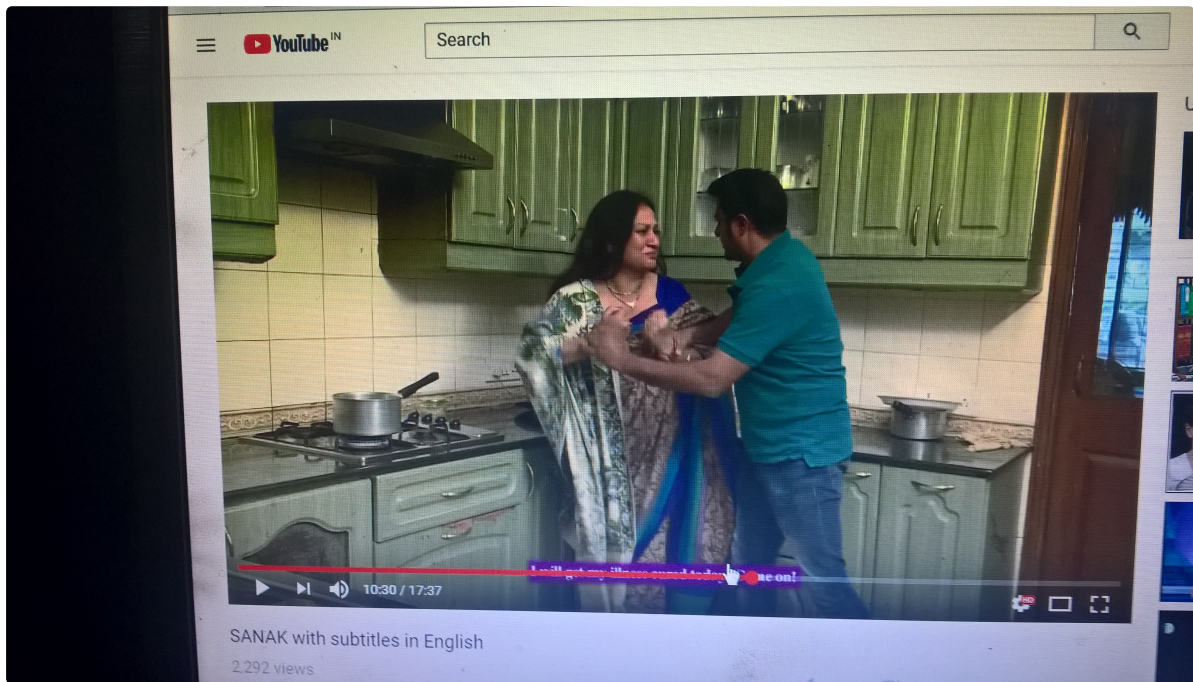


Say No to sexual violence against women
