

SC hearing NRC related petitions



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NEW DELHI: The Supreme Court is hearing a set of 17 NRC related petitions on Wednesday.

A division bench of Justice [Ranjan](#) Gogoi and Justice F Nariman is hearing these petitions.

The court is expected to clear its ruling on the validity of the panchayat [documents](#) as evidence in the process to update NRC.

On Thursday, the court is hearing the Centre's plea to extend the deadline for publication of NRC draft till July 31, 2018 instead of December 31, 2017.

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
