Many organizations in [Manipur](#) have welcomed the Supreme Court ruling [against](#) the excessive use of army and para military forces in the counter insurgency operations.

Talking to Assam Times [over](#) telephone from [Imphal](#) human [rights](#) activist Babloo Loitongbum said they are happy with the ruling. “Yes, we welcome the judgment. I am waiting for the copy of the judgment to go through in detail.”

Manu Charutvedi, a Delhi High Court lawyer told Assam Times [over](#) telephone that the apex court ruling will help be a huge boost for the human [rights](#) organizations who have been crying [against](#) the Arms Forces Special Powers [Act](#).

“The Court talks of an independent probe into the allegations of fake encounters. But it is not clear whether it be set up under the commission of enquiry [Act](#) or a government controlled panel.”

These organizations have reached hours after the country’s apex court got tougher with the excessive use of forces in the counter insurgency operation in [Manipur](#).
