

SC ruling on NRC draft date likely



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NEW DELHI: The Supreme court is hearing a crucial [petition](#) on NRC on Thursday where the Centre seeks a period of six more months to publish the draft.

A division bench of the top court comprising Justice [Ranjan](#) Gogoi and Justice FA Nariman is hearing the Centre's seeking extension of the deadline to publish the NRC date till July 31,2018 instead of December 31,2017.

The court which heard a set of more than 30 petitions relating to NRC on Wednesday is expected to clear its ruling on the validity of the panchayat [documents](#) to support citizenship in NRC.

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
