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In yet another attack on media, suspected NDBF(S) militants shot a journalist in their captivity in [Udalguri](#) district sending shock and anger across the state.

The incident took place on Saturday wee hours when the ultras forcibly took away local correspondent of a vernacular daily Prasanta Kumar to an undisclosed locations to be shot at after inflicting torture in their captivity.

They charged Kumar with writing [against](#) the outfit.

A seriously injured Kumar

managed to go to a nearby house for help.

The local residents rushed him to hospital before being shifted to the Gauhati Medical College.
