

Senior journalist Ajit Bhuyan step downs from Prag News



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Senior journalist Ajit Kr. Bhuyan has stepped down from Guwahati based satellite news channel Prag News as it's chief editor.

Bhuyan, who has been playing a major role in mass mobilisation for the on-going anti-CAA protest in the state, on Saturday formally submitted his resignation.

Bhuyan, who has been active in journalism for the last three decade, is the founder editor of Asomiya Pratidin, the largest circulated Assamese newspaper.

He was also the founding editor of Aji.

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
