

Senior leaders back Gogoi



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A section of senior leaders is believed to have taken the side of Tarun [Gogoi](#) as chief minister who is set to meet the [dissident](#) ministers and ministers on Monday evening.

Sources told [Assam](#) Times that the chief minister has agreed to accommodate senior MLAs in his soon to be reshuffled [council](#) of ministers. If need be, [Gogoi](#) has agreed to [reshuffle](#) his [cabinet](#) after a period of six months.

[Gogoi](#) is believed to have conveyed his decision to [Sarat Borkotoky](#). Dr Bhumidhar Barman on [Sunday](#) evening before Dr [Himanta](#) Biswa [Sarma](#) called on him at Koinadhara hilltop.

Apart from [45](#) MLAs, [Gogoi](#) has already got assurance of support from five senior leaders who talked to him over telephone during the last 12 hours.

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
