In yet another high voltage drama that changes the [state](#)'s political landscape in [Arunachal](#) Pradesh, Chief Minister Pema Khandu and the [Congress](#) legislators, mostly, have joined People's Party of [Arunachal](#) on Thursday.

Except [Nabam](#) Tuki who helped Khandu become the new Chief Minister remained in the ruling party a month after Kalikho Pul commite suicide.

The development took place just two months after the Supreme Court restored Tuki [as](#) Chief Minister in the [Congress](#) government. The north eastern [state](#) has 60 assembly seats and [Congress](#) had 47 MLAs while BJP has 11 with two independents.
