

Sixth North East Trade Expo-2009 is underway in Delhi



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The Sixth North East Trade Expo-2009 is underway in Delhi which is drawing huge crowd. Organized jointly by DONER and National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC), the event was inaugurated by DONER Minister Mani Shankar Aiyar on Tuesday.
