

Skill Development Programme for OBC candidates



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Indian Institute of Entrepreneurship ([IIE](#)) is organising a series of Stipendiary Training Programmes for unemployed youth belong to other backward class (OBC) [community](#) in Assam, [Manipur](#) and [Tripura](#). The programmes are being supported by [National](#) Backward Classes Finance and [Development](#) Corporation (NBCFDC) and to be held in February and March this year.
