

Social media photograph costs jailar's job



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DIBRUGARH: [Social](#) media brews trouble for yet another government officer who has faced suspension only because of a photograph. He is none other than Aroop Patangia, the Dibrugarh central jail superintendent whom the government suspended on Thursday acting on a photograph which went viral in [social](#) media.

According to information, [Congress](#) MLA and Opposition [leader](#) Debobrata Saikia and his Mariani counterpart Rupjyoti Kurmi very recently visited KMSS [leader](#) Akhil Gogoi inside the jail. Towards the end the duo had a photo session with the peasant [leader](#) who was hailed under the [National](#) Security Act.

The photograph was uploaded and then went viral in social media. Now the authority had blamed it all on the jail superintendent for not disallowing it to happen. He was suspended on Thursday.

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NAZIRA, September 27, 2026 — Tension continues to prevail in Nazira, particularly in the Santak-Bihubar area, following the killing of Biman Barua, president of the Rangajan Yuva Samaj and a youth social worker, on September 18 under Bihubar Police Station.

Following the killing, local residents have been demanding stringent punishment for the alleged masterminds, Ravindra Singh alias Vicky Singh and Rubul Khan, besides seeking demolition of Vicky Singh's residence.

Meanwhile, Sivasagar district police have taken Vicky Singh and Rubul Khan into custody and are questioning them at the district headquarters police station in connection with the murder case and allegations of drug-related activities.

According to police sources, the two allegedly told investigators during questioning that drugs were brought from Dimapur and Nagaland and stored at the residence of Vicky Singh's sister in Nazira town. The drugs were allegedly supplied from the house to users in different parts of Nazira and Sivasagar.

Based on the information allegedly obtained during the questioning, a joint team of Bihubar Police and Nazira Model Police Station conducted a raid at the residence of Vicky Singh's sister, Rinki Singh Bora, in Ward No. 6 of Nazira town on Saturday morning.

Police detained Rinki Singh Bora and are reportedly questioning her in connection with the alleged storage and distribution of drugs.

The investigation into the murder of Biman Barua and the alleged drug network is continuing.
