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GUWAHATI: [Nagaland](#) Chief Minister TR Zeliang and his Assam counterpart Sarbananda Sonowal has met his Assam counterpart Sarbananda Sonowal have agreed to formulate a slew of strategies to move the Centre to improve connectivity network in the north eastern region. The duo met in Guwahati on Monday where they discussed a common strategy for a connectivity boost.
