

Sonowal talks Nagalim issue with Rajnath



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NEw DELHI: Amid an escalating protest [over](#) the Centre's preparedness for Nagalim settlement even by compromising territorial integrity with Assam, [Arunachal](#) Pradesh and [Manipur](#), Sarbananda Sonowal hunkered down with Rajnath Singh in [New Delhi](#) on Monday where Nagalim issue was believed to have dominated.
