Earlier on 8th June 2012 - "ABASTHAN DHARMAGHAT" was observed by all the members of district unit at respective District Mission Office & by all the members of State Mission Office Unit at the State Mission Office (SMO) from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. and on 12th & 13th June 2012 - "KARMA BIRATI" was observed by all members at respective level.

Talking to the media they warned the government as well as the high authorities of SSA to launch stronger democratic agitation if it fails to fulfil their demands immediately.
