The [National](#) Investigation Agency is believed to have got more startling revelations on the [Adivasi](#) massacre during the interrogation of three dreaded NDFB-S rebels who were held in [Nagaland](#) on Thursday. Sources told Assam Times that the rebels confessed that it was Ajoy Basumatary who insturcted to carry out the gory massacre in Sonitpur district. Ajoy along with Dilip Basumatary, and Khamrei Basumatary were held in [Nagaland](#) on Thursday.

Dilip is no less responsible. He was Dilip, who co-ordinated the operation in the forest areas along the India-Bhutan border. Similarly, NIA claimed to have learnt that Khamrei is one of the main suspects in the recent killing of 20 people in Assam's Kokrajhar district.

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
