

State employees warn stronger agitation at Haflong

Hundreds of state employees, working in different departments under the administrative control of Dima Hasao Autonomous Council took out procession with the demand of immediate release of their salaries on Tuesday at Haflong.

The procession led by Haflong District Karmachari Parishad, Dima Hasao was taken out from the Cultural institute Hall marched to the Dima Hasao Autonomous Council main gate and resorted to shouting and demanding the release of the salary immediately.

They are not getting their salaries some for last three months and some for seven months due to lackadaisical attitude of Finance Department of Dima Hasao Autonomous Council which has submitted the audit report lately, they alleged.

The Chairman, Dima Hasao Autonomous Council however assured the agitating employees to clear up their salaries within seven days. The state employees warned both the State and Council government that if their salaries were not paid within 7 days then they would close all the government offices under the administrative control of Dima Hasao Autonomous Council.
