

Steps to deal with crimes on NH



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A special Highway Patrol unit of the [Assam](#) Police is coming up to deal with accidents and crimes on National Highways.

Official sources told [Assam](#) Times that the decision got chief minister's nod at a [meeting](#) between Chief Minister Tarun [Gogoi](#) with [Assam DGP Khagen](#) Sarma.

The [DGP](#) said that the [meeting](#) that the [accident](#) prone areas have been identified and highway patrolling would be focused on these areas.

Almost one lakh verification cases are received by the [police](#) annually in the state and Sarma said the process is on to bring down the cases of verification in some districts of the state.

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
