The Raha Police recovered a [bike](#) stolen from Dighaliati village under Raha police station on Monday morning. According to police the [bike](#) was owned by one Kangkon Jyoti Bhuyan, an inhabitant of Dighaliati village. According to the information received, the [bike](#) bearing no. AS-02-G 3296 went missing since Sunday night at around 12.55 a.m. from the owner's residence.

"The stolen [bike](#) was spotted at a field covered with dense shrubs in the early hours on Monday by some locals of the area upon which the police was informed," police said. Police suspect that the [bike lifters](#) dumped the [bike](#) there failing to [start](#) it due to some technical snag. Further investigation is on. No one has been arrested till now in this connection.
