In a tragic road mishap occurred this morning here at Rangiya Tiniali under Rangiya PS, a minor class I student Gitartha Talukdar received severe injuries when a very high speeding Tata winger vehicle hit him near Tinali railgate here on his way to school located just nearby by place of occurrence of the incident.
