

Target Dristi Rajkhowa!



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TURA: Security forces in and around Adangpak village in the [East Garo Hills](#) of [Meghalaya](#) are continuing the massive operation in search of another dreaded north eastern rebel [leader](#) a day after they eliminated [GNLA](#) chief Sohan D Shira at an encounter.

Dense jungles in the entire huge area are being cordoned off to locate Dristi [Rajkhowa](#) acting on an input of the presence of [ULFA](#)(I) deputy Commander in Chief.

Round-the-clock vigil is in place along the Indo- Bangla border to prevent these dreaded rebels from leaving the north eastern [state](#).

Similar vigil is also there along the Assam-[Meghalaya](#) inter [state](#) border apprehending attempt of the [ULFA](#)-I [leader](#) and close aide of Presh Barua to enter into his home [state](#).

Inputs have suggested presence of [Rajkhowa](#) along with Sohan in the same team till the encounter took place where the [GNLA](#) chief was shot dead.

The fierce gun battle took place two four days after the Garo rebels killed [NCP](#) candidate Jonathone N Sangma along with his two associates and two security [guards](#)



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
