

Tea workers hurt in firing



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GOLAGHAT: At least [ten](#) tea garden [workers](#) sustained injury when their owners sprang upon them by gun firing in Golaghat district on Wednesday.

The bizarre incident took place in Bogidhola Tea Estate near Numligarh in the morning. A small [group](#) of [workers](#) approached owner RS Ray demanding wages and bonus. When denied they got angry with the owner who scolded them.

Then the high voltage drama touch down a new low and Ray took his rifle and started firing upon the [workers](#).

Six [workers](#) sustained injury in the incident who have been shifted to the Golaghat Civil Hospital. [One](#) is said to be in critical condition.

Then other [workers](#) thronged the spot and lodged a complaint before the police who are investigating the firing incident.

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
