

Third H1N1 case detected in Assam



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Assam confirms its third H1N1 virus infection case when a youth in Dibrugarh tested positive on Tuesday. The patient is Manjot Gogoi, a resident of Milon Nagar in Dibrugarh who is undergoing treatment at the Assam Medical College Hospital in Dibrugarh. The confirmation came

from the Regional Medical Research Centre at Lahowal in Dibrugarh. That too a few hours after an ex army jawan Raj Kumar Sinha tested positive . Raj Kumar, who hail from Silchar in Assam is an employee with Reliance in Mumbai. He came to Assam on Sunday and was admitted

at the Army base Hospital in Basistha after he complained of swine flu symptoms.
