

Three arrested in Junu Sarma murder case

GUWAHATI: The Kamrup Police have arrested three persons in connection with the murder of senior State Bank [India](#) ([SBI](#)) official Junu Sarma. Police in a pre-dawn raid on Sunday arrested the three persons—Putul Ali alias Saddam Hussain, Sunil Kumar Mishra and Pranab Kalita from different places. While Putul alias Saddam is a loan recovery agent, Mishra is an official of [SBI](#)'s Dadara branch. Pranab, who was detained by police for

questioning after the incident, is a [driver](#) of the [vehicle](#) of bank official Sarma. The arrested accused persons were produced in the Kamrup CJM's court, which sent them to 14-day police custody. The 56-year-old woman official of [SBI](#)'s Dadara branch was shot dead by unidentified [gunmen](#) at Agyathuri under Dadara police station on the outskirts of Guwahati on Tuesday night (Oct 9) while she was returning from office to her residence at Nizarapar in Chandmari here. Assam DGP Kuladhar Saikia said that the way things seem to have unfolded certainly makes it a case of a pre-planned murder. "We are probing all possible angles that have emerged so far, especially the one related to bank-related operation. We would get to the root of the case very [soon](#)," Saikia had said. He said that the statements of all the eye-witnesses have been recorded and the investigators are on .
