

Three elephants electrocuted to death in two places



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GUWAHATI: In yet another bizarre incident that sends huge shockwaves across the animal lovers, three wild elephants were electrocuted to death in two different incidents in the [state](#) on Monday.

The first [tragic](#) incident took place in Amguri where two full grown female elephants were electrocuted as a herd of elephants which came down from the nearby hills in search of food landed at Tiphuk Tea garden in the wee hours.

Local tea garden [workers](#) spotted the body in the morning. "Very [tragic](#), pathetic indeed. Both the female elephants perhaps were moving under the high voltage wires," said Vinit [Munda](#), a local tea garden worker.

The second one incident of elephant electrocution took place in Numligarh, the place where [over](#) a dozen of wild elephants were electrocuted to death during the last two years.

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
