

Torch light rally in Kokrajhar



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KOKRAJHAR: A torch light cum prayer rally was organised in Kokrajhar on Sunday evening to pray for a fruitful peace talk in between interlocutor Mathur and [National](#) Democratic Front of Boroland(NDFB),scheduled to be held on Monday(25th June) in [New Delhi over](#) Bodoland statehood issue.
