

Torch rally demanding Bodoland.



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Reiterating its movement for separate Bodoland [state](#), activists of All Bodo Students' Union (ABSU), under the aegis of six regional committees viz. [Dimakuchi](#), Khagrabari, Khoirabari, [Bhergaon](#), Panery and [Tangla](#) supported by [PJACBM](#) and NDFB (P), took out a massive torch light rally throughout [Tangla](#) town on Wednesday evening.
