

Torch rally seeking Bodoland, Gorkhaland



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The All Bodo Students Union (ABSU), NDFB-P, [PJACBM](#) in association with All Assam Gorkha Students Union (AAGSU) organized a torch rally in Kokrajhar seeking early creation of Bodoland [state](#) and extending solidarity to the Gorkhaland situation on Thursday.

Nearly two thousand activists from ABSU, NDFB-P, [PJACBM](#) and AAGSU with banner, placards joined hands in the rally, which was started from Bodofa Children Park in Kokrajhar that traversed to JD Road, fly [over](#) and concluded at Pragati Bhawan. The rallies' shouted slogans demanding early creation of smaller states, including Bodoland, Gorkhaland [state](#) under Article [2](#) & 3 of Indian constitution to pave way good governance and healthy development in the region.
