

## Transit remand for Burling Bhutur

The Assam Police on Saturday got Burling Bhutur on transit remand a day after the dreaded NDFB-S rebel was arrested in Bangalore.

The wanted rebel is allegedly involved in the killing of six [Adivasi](#) people at Lungsung on December 23 apart from killing of [6](#) Hindi-speaking people in Sarfang guri on January 16.

A team of police from Guwahati is on the way back from Bangaluru on Saturday along with the NDFB-S [leader](#) whom police caught acting on tipoff from their Assam counterpart.

Notably, he was also wanted in the gory Serfang guri [carnage](#) where he and his group pulled down around 12 passengers from a bus and shot [6](#) of them dead at Athiabari.

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## Nazira tension persists after youth leader's killing; police probe alleged drug network

**NAZIRA, September 27, 2026** — Tension continues to prevail in Nazira, particularly in the Santak-Bihubar area, following the killing of Biman Barua, president of the Rangajan Yuva Samaj and a youth social worker, on September 18 under Bihubar Police Station.

Following the killing, local residents have been demanding stringent punishment for the alleged masterminds, Ravindra Singh alias Vicky Singh and Rubul Khan, besides seeking demolition of Vicky Singh's residence.

Meanwhile, Sivasagar district police have taken Vicky Singh and Rubul Khan into custody and are questioning them at the district headquarters police station in connection with the murder case and allegations of drug-related activities.

According to police sources, the two allegedly told investigators during questioning that drugs were brought from Dimapur and Nagaland and stored at the residence of Vicky Singh's sister in Nazira town. The drugs were allegedly supplied from the house to users in different parts of Nazira and Sivasagar.

Based on the information allegedly obtained during the questioning, a joint team of Bihubar Police and Nazira Model Police Station conducted a raid at the residence of Vicky Singh's sister, Rinki Singh Bora, in Ward No. 6 of Nazira town on Saturday morning.

Police detained Rinki Singh Bora and are reportedly questioning her in connection with the alleged storage and distribution of drugs.

The investigation into the murder of Biman Barua and the alleged drug network is continuing.
