Kokrajhar: Amid simmering protest [over](#) land [rights](#) issue of the non Boro people in BTAD areas, an executive BTC body meeting in Kokrajhar agreed said that the general caste cant procure the land [rights](#) of the tribals anywhere in the area.

BTAD chief [Hagrama Mohilary](#) who chaired the meeting said a plot of land is transferable only within the general category people. "The tribal can buy and transfer land from general category. But the general category people can't buy or transfer of tribal plot," said Mohilary.

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
