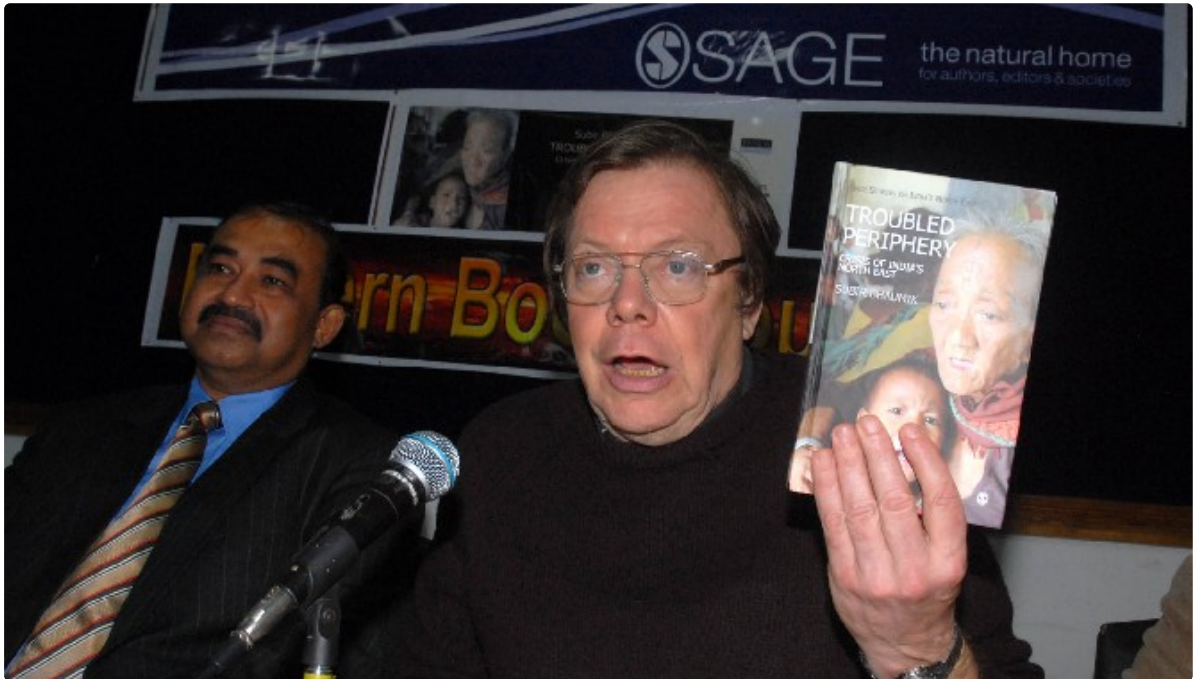


Troubled Periphery- crisis of India's north east
