

Two killed in Train mishap

Two persons including a woman were killed in a train mishap took place on Monday 6:15 pm at railway lines of Tuhura village under Kamalpur Police Station. According to the Railway Police Sources, One Abdul Hannan Dewan tried to cross the railway line by one white Maruti van but it was suddenly hit by Up North Express. The driver cum owner of Maruti van Abdul Hannan Dewan (40) and his mother Maijan Bibi (60) who was one of the passengers of the Maruti van were killed on the spot.

The van was totally destroyed in the incident due to which the number of the vehicle has not been recovered till this time. The train stopped for half an hour after the incident. Later Baihata Railway Police cleared the railway track and the train started the journey. It is to be noted that there is no railway gate at Tuhura but people cross railway line with their vehicles illegally. The investigation is on regarding the incident.

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
