UDALGURI:

The [Udalguri](#) district committee of All Koch-Rajbongshi Students' Union (AKRSU) is preparing to enforce a 24 hour long [Udalguri](#) district [bandh](#) on February 15 alleging [failure](#) of BTAD administration to keep its promises.

Talking to reporters, Aranya Deka, A Saikia and B. Rajbongshi, alleged that despite full support to the ruling BPF in the last BTC elections, the BTC authority did not fulfill its assurance to construct a students' hostel for the community at [Udalguri](#) and intentionally directed to construct it outside [Udalguri](#) town area. The decision was taken at a district unit meeting of AKRSU, where the [leaders](#) criticized the present role of the BTC authority in the region.
