

ULFA at war with Himanta



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A heavy exchange of words between Himanta Biswa Sarma and Ulfa seems to have kept political landscape boiling in Assam. Ulfa on Monday called the powerful minister their former colleague a day after Dr Sarma tore apart Ulfa C-in-Chief Paresh Barua. Dr Sarma further on Monday questioned silence from Ulfa during the last ten years if was really an Ulfa member.
