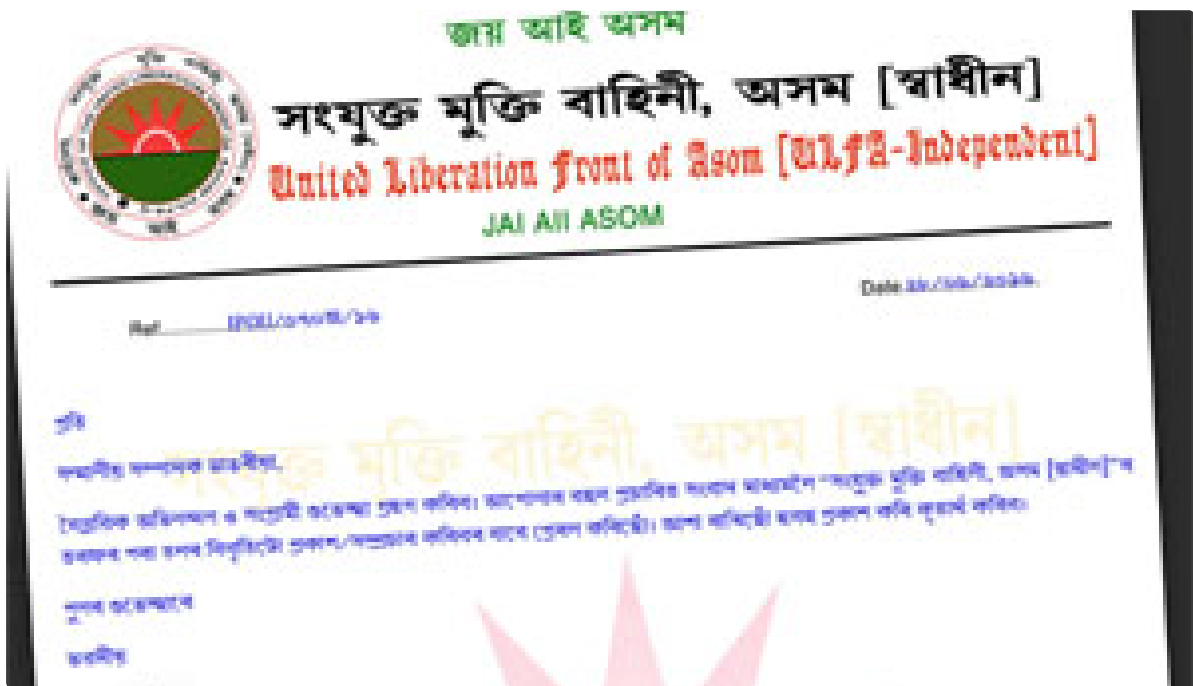


ULFA-I opposes oil field auction
