

ULFA-I releases Arunav Phukan



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MARGHERITA: The United Liberation Front of Asom (I) on Sunday released Arunav Phukan 10 days after they kidnapped the businessman from Khandubasti in [Arunachal](#) Pradesh.

Arunav, the son of a leading business man in [Tinsukia](#) has been freed at Joyrampur along the Assam-[Arunachal](#) Pradesh border at noon from where he called up his mother in Jagun.

A team of [Tinsukia](#) police is on the way to Joirampur to take stock of his condition whom the rebel outfit kidnapped at gunpoint as he was on the way to visit his [father](#)'s stone quarry.

Security forces were fanning thr dense jungle along the interstate border in search of Arunav after he was kidnapped by s [group](#) of 6 [ULFA](#)(I) rebels.

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
