

ULFA(I) serves quit Assam notices to NHPC, NEEPCO



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The United Liberation Front of Asom (I) has served quit Assam notice to NHPC and NEEPCO warning the hydel power giants of dire consequences.

In a statement issued to media on Monday, the rebel outfit struggling for an independent Assam said the flood [waters](#) wreaked no less havoc in Lakhimpur and Dhemaji district when NEEPCO released excess [waters](#) from its Ranganadi dam.
