

ULFA(I) threatens more strike



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The United Liberation Front of [Asom](#)(I) has owned up the responsibility of the explosion at an ONGC pipeline in Sonari on Saturday.

In a statement issued to media on Sunday, the rebel outfit said that they will continue these until and unless sovereignty is restored on the [indigenous](#) people.

An ONGC pipeline was partially damaged when the explosion took place at Teok Ghat with a huge sound in Sonari district in the evening.

Security forces and senior ONGC officials initially could not ascertain [ULFA](#)'s role in the incident which took place two days after an Ulfa rebel died in Dikom [as](#) he was believed to have been planting a bomb at an OIL pipeline which exploded immediately.

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
