

ULFA strikes again: 1 dead in blast



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After a brief respite from ethnic frenzy, Bongaigaon skips into yet another orgy of violence when ULFA exploded a powerful grenade leaving one dead and three others injured. But the ULFA member who made the grenade attack was captured hours after the incident. He has confessed the nefarious deed saying that the target was the security forces. The blast took in Bongaigaon township near a flyover on Tuesday evening.

Notably, on September 8, a CRPF man was killed and 12 others injured in an IED blast at Paltan Bazar in Guwahati.
