

ULFA talk: Ball in Dispur's court



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The Centre on Wednesday smartly passed the buck on to the state government after the SJA delegation camping in Delhi met P Chidambaram in the evening. The Union home minister said the state government can only release the jailed ULFA leaders to help them take a formal decision. Led by renowned critic Dr Hiren Gohain, the SJA team called on Chidambaram at 4.30 in the afternoon.
