AASU's 12 hour ultimatum is [over](#). Soobodh Biswas is still on the run 5 days after he incited the violence in Silapothar where a local AASU office was ransacked. The [state](#)'s influential [student](#) body is on a statewide [Satyagraha](#) in protest [against](#) the [failure](#) to nab the Silapothar culprit.

AASU [workers](#) in the district and sub divisional headquarters started satyagraha from morning on Friday raising doubts [over](#) the sincerity of the government to hold Biswas. AASU served the 12 hour ultimatum to the [chief](#) minister on Wednesday.
