Assam legislative assembly got underway in Dispur amid a story note on Monday. Opposition [Congress](#) and AIUDF did not allow governor Banwarilal Purohit to complete his speech to mark the [start](#) of the session which will end in March.

Uproar started [as soon as](#) the governor appreciated the Sarbananda Sonowal government for good governance and [fight against](#) corruption.

[Congress](#) and AIUDF members stood up and raised strong protest [against](#) the speech. They shouted that the [state](#) has never seen any [sign](#) of good and transparent governance. Price rise, law and order are still remaining a grave issue, said [Congress](#) legislators supported by AIUDF members. A section of the members from the treasury bench tried to counter the opposition members with utter noise. Amid a deafening din, governor Purohit concluded his 77 page speech halfway.

Finance minister Himanta Biswa Sarma will table the annual finance budget on February [7](#).

[As](#) the House assembled in the morning Jorhat MLA Hiten Goswami filed nomination papers for the post of Speaker and was elected unanimously. Chief minister Sonowal, opposition [leader](#) Debobrata Saikia welcomed Goswami who hoped cooperation from all sides.
